Councils across the Clyde Valley are reviewing the potential for shared services. UNISON's not opposed to public bodies sharing services, but we are against the creation of public service factories for so-called 'back office' services. This outdated approach has been widely criticised for providing high costs and poor service.

The review's approach is outdated too, having developed in conditions of secrecy, without proper input from the staff who deliver services. It also makes a number of sweeping assumptions about future savings with no evidence to support them.
